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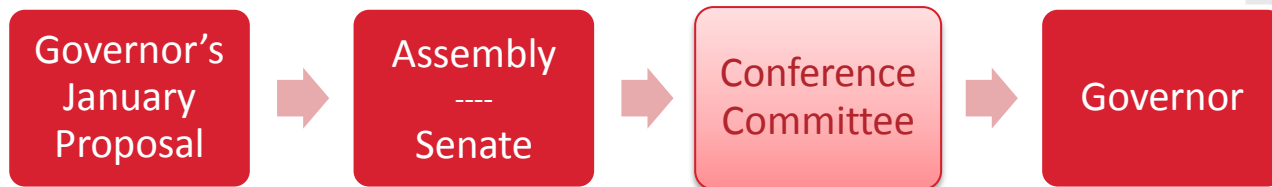
State Legislative & Budget: Year in Review

SB 1055

- Would have updated current SBHC grant program in statute (created in 2006)
- Died in the Senate in May

Budget Advocacy

- We got farther in this process than we ever have before
- But our item died in the Conference Committee





State Policy Updates

Health Delivery System Reforms

- Strategic Plan Priority 3: Advocate for health care financing for the key elements of the school-based health model that are not currently reimbursed.
 - Other health providers think about SBHCs as part of the delivery system
 - The current ways that SBHCs do prevention and public health are supported in the new reforms
