La Clínica de La Raza, Inc – FQHC with 8 SBHCs in Alameda County, 2 in Oakland Elev8 project

UCSF Nursing (SON): faculty with expertise in adolescent care, school-based settings. Trainee participation in SBHC activities through service-learning opportunities

UCSF Dentistry (SOD): public health approach and student elective volunteers

UCSF Elev8 Healthy Students & Families - funded initial community-academic partnership

Havenscourt Health Center, East Oakland, part of network of 29 Alameda County SBHC.



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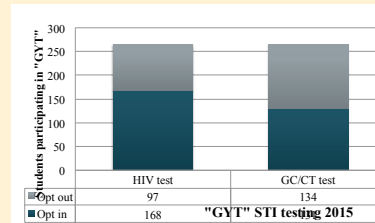
What, Where, When

The Prototype: “Get Yourself Tested” Campaign Havenscourt Health Center

8th – 12th grade students targeted
Brief classroom outreach and education on reproductive health topics, rights and resources for students – with a focus on SBHC services

Brief 1:1 health education and sexual health screening assessment with Health Educators, Nurse Practitioners, SON Preceptors and SON students

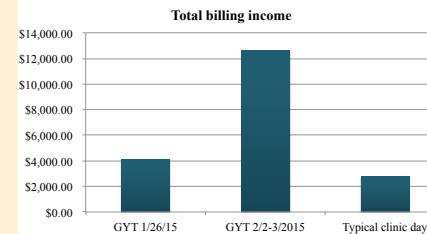
Opportunity for opt-out GC/CT testing and onsite Orasure



HOW: the Prep Work for 3 days, 200+ Students DAY OF: Providers & NP Students

Task	HRS
Schedule times to enroll students during class	5
Enroll students during classes (4 30 min. periods/grade = 20 classes)**	10
Register or re-activate 200+ students in FPACT	10-15
Scheduling students in EMR	3
Prep, administer, HE day of the event (8 hours per day)**	24
Log Orasure HIV testing and GC/CT testing **	10
Total cost (estimated) -- ~ \$1500-\$2400	70

Why

La Clínica de la Raza – expand reach into middle schools, where youth are not as likely to present on their own

- Increased integration with school, school programs
- Addressing unmet health needs

UCSF School of Nursing – commitment to train providers skilled in working with underserved youth

- need to expand innovative/ alternative clinical placements for students,
- Address unmet health needs

Implications, Next steps
